It was fantastic what the children at the wooden village near the Rohda field constructed. The houses and the stages for the various performances were a sight for sore eyes, as were the handmade musical instruments and the various enthusiastic performances. But where the wooden homes were built here as a form of playing, many inhabitants of Sri Lanka have to live like this in reality. Especially after the Tsunami there are still many people who receive little basic aid but no further aid and home. This is why we are very pleased with the proceeds of this action, which allows us to help people in north-east Sri Lanka. All proceeds will go directly to its destination. No money disappears. Because the aid and attention of 555 still does not reach north-east Sri Lanka. These people only receive aid from small foundations and private initiatives. The proceeds of the Rohda wooden village will contribute to financial support, to allow children to go to school and buy them uniforms and materials. The proceeds exceeded our expectations:

512,77 euros. Many thanks to everyone. Also thanks to the volunteers who helped in this wooden village. We are still urgently looking for sponsors and donors to aid the people in this region, so that they also can lead a decent and worthy life. The Tsunami seems a long time ago, but the situation is dire, we cannot forget these people. We are grateful for every euro that is donated.
